Congratulations to the 2015-16 CGA Educational Foundation College Scholarship recipients. This year, 327 scholarships totaling \$552,500 were awarded to deserving students attending college this fall – which represents a nearly \$150,000 increase over last year’s award total.

Beginning with a single scholarship in 1992, the Foundation has grown exponentially over the last 24 years to bestow more than 2,600 worthy college students with awards totaling more than \$4 million — ensuring that California’s grocery employees and their dependents have the resources necessary to start or complete their higher education.

The scholarship program includes four types of scholarships: CGAEF Funded, Legacy, Donor, and Piggyback.

CGA Educational Foundation college scholarships are open to high school seniors, college undergraduates and graduate students who are employees, or the dependents of employees, of California Grocers Association member companies.

“CGAEF scholarship donors are investing in the development of tomorrow’s grocery industry leaders,” said CGAEF Executive Director Shiloh London. “We are grateful for the tremendous ongoing support of CGA member companies which allow the Foundation an opportunity to provide college scholarships to deserving students.”

The CGA Educational Foundation was created under the direction of the California Grocers Association Board of Directors in 1991. Its mission is to provide financial assistance to advance the educational goals of CGA member company employees and their dependents and offer educational programs to advance the grocery industry.

PARTNERSHIPS *for the* FUTURE

In 2014, California Grocers Association Educational Foundation and California Polytechnic State University (Cal Poly) Agribusiness Department embarked on a partnership designed to help shape future generations of grocery industry professionals in a wide range of disciplines through support of Cal Poly's Food Retail Management Program.

While enrolled in Cal Poly's Agribusiness Food Retail Management Program (CPAFRM), students will take a set of core classes, including economics, accounting, finance, marketing, sales, data analysis, quantitative methods, agriculture and food policy, and human resources management. Elective courses include Agribusiness Supply Chain Management, Transportation and Logistics in Global Agribusiness, Food Category Management and Fact-Based Selling with Scanner Data, Food Retail Management, Advanced Sales Techniques, Field Studies, and Food Retail Internships.

As part of its commitment to recruit the next generation of grocery industry executives, the Foundation will fund scholarships, internships, and professional development opportunities:

- CGAEF will award four (4) \$5,000 scholarships to Cal Poly students that have completed a minimum of 8 units of CPAFRM classes with a 3.0 grade point average.
- CGAEF will provide Cal Poly students enrolled in Food Retail Management coursework that are completing a grocery industry internship with \$1,000 stipends to help defray the costs of housing, food, and transportation.
- CGAEF will sponsor Cal Poly students to attend the annual California Grocers Association Strategic Conference, including the cost of registration, hotel, conference meals and a travel stipend. Attendance at the annual Conference will provide Cal Poly students and faculty and grocery industry representatives the opportunity to build mutually beneficial relationships.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Jay Noel, chair and professor of Cal Poly's Agribusiness Department, knows that with 12,000 traditional U.S. food outlets selling more than \$570 billion worth of retail food and nonfood products annually, significant job opportunities exist for properly prepared graduates.

So in 2011, he set out to develop a program that would do just that — prepare graduates for leadership roles in the food retail management area. At the time, the department was developing program or career areas of focus. “We developed a strategic plan for the department with the goal to secure more public-private partnerships,” Noel said.


That goal became a reality in September 2014, when the California Grocers Association Educational Foundation (CGAEF) announced a historic partnership with Cal Poly designed to strengthen California's future grocery industry workforce. The CGAEF will fund \$25,000 to provide scholarships, internship stipends, and professional development opportunities for students taking courses in the in the Agribusiness Food Retail Management Program curriculum.

This is the first higher education partnership in the CGAEF's 22-year history, and it didn't happen overnight. Louie Brown, chair of the Agribusiness Department's advisory council and a lawyer and lobbyist whose client base includes the California Grocers Association, arranged a meeting between Noel and Shiloh London, Executive Director, CGA Educational Foundation. “We are looking for practice-ready graduates who can step right into the grocery industry,” said London. “This is a great match.”

The partnership is designed to help shape future generations of grocery industry professionals in a wide range of disciplines, including grocery store management, category (produce, meat, etc.) management, sales and marketing, purchasing and procurement and customer relations.

Cal Poly's stellar reputation certainly played a role in the foundation's decision to fund the program. And it didn't hurt that the three agribusiness students who attended CGA's annual meeting in September just happened to "wow" everyone with their "superior interpersonal skills and ability to carry on a good conversation. Everyone who met them was impressed," Noel said.

In return for its investment, the CGA-member companies get a pipeline to Cal Poly students, Noel said. "This can cut down on recruitment costs, which can be very high. Studies show that students who have completed internships start the job up-to-speed with little or no training needed, are more productive, and tend to stay on the job longer."

The program will facilitate internship opportunities with CGA-member companies and foster additional learning opportunities

for students and faculty. On average, more than 100 agribusiness students complete an internship each year.

"The agreement is a win-win for the students, too," Noel said. "They have a Learn by Doing opportunity to use their skills, gain industry experience, and get to find out about a company to see if they like it," Noel said. "It is a very powerful experience to include on their resumes."

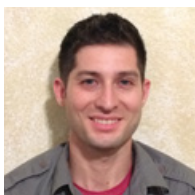
Noel expects the program to grow both in terms of finances and internships. "It is one of those things you have to build on.
